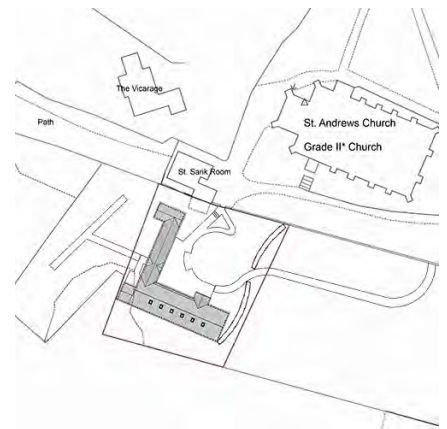




ST. ANDREWS CHURCH HALL, SONNING

This restricted site adjacent to St Andrews Church was a prime location for a much needed church hall for the parish. Careful consideration of the surroundings was required as the site is in a conservation area. The final proposal is an L shaped pitched roof structure, with a main hall in the larger wing and parish offices in the smaller wing. Modern construction techniques will be used to minimise the impact on the site. Planning has been achieved and construction will begin shortly.

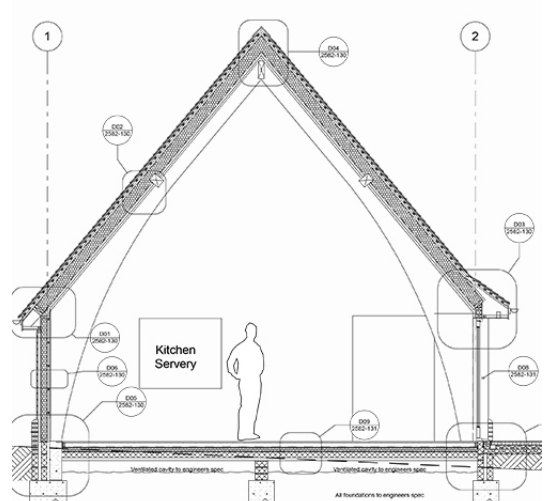
